



Espace Fxmme

ESPACE FXMME - WOMXI SPACE, created shortly before the pandemic, is a time-based space that takes place every Thursday at Globe Aroma. It is a platform for female/non-binary artists and creatives to establish a safer space in an environment previously dominated by a male presence.

In the last year, Espace Fxmme has been developing the TOLK WITH THE WOLLS trajectory, as a reflection, design exercise and action on how space best reflects our values (intersectionality, solidarity, participation, creativity, inclusion, care).

Previous iterations of the TQLK WITH THE WQLLS trajectory, were: the safer space design workshop, building the modular furniture and THE MUPQL.

Since October, Espace Fxmme is working on the last iteration of the trajectory (GETTING SOFTER) based around different techniques of textiles design. (Weaving, Batik, Embroidery and more). Climing to create softer vessels of hospitality.

Le Maillot - One Size Fits QII

LE MQILLOT - ONE SIZE FITS QLL unites a group of performers with different artistic practices - such as dance, photography, fashion, video and athletics, and all with football as their common passion - to work around the football shirt, and the infinite cultural and physical meanings attached to it.

This production was born out of a meeting between Chilan Ratnamohan, Sergio Belo Fanck, Climu Mahammad, Lia Conceiçao and Issouf Ilboudo. They came together to explore football movements, but what emerged most was a common interest in fashion or design from completely different perspectives. Chilan also invited footballers Mahy Nambiar and Oumar Diallo.

Starting from the action of pulling a shirt - which in a football match puts you in contact with your opponent and is typically considered an aggressive game - they try to take this action to the extreme, to deconstruct its aggressive and competitive nature, in order to create something new.

In this way, football shirts take on a new meaning. The history and cultural implications of each piece of fabric transcend the initial associations surrounding the garment. It's countries, it's clubs, it's cities, it's villages, it's sponsors, it's oil companies, it's memorabilia and it's fashion; the players, their models and the high fashion suppliers. But who is able to provide this haute couture?
